

### Formation of a new branch

The issue was recently raised as to how a new branch should be formed. A branch is formed by the County Committee, acting on behalf of the Central Committee.

An inaugural meeting is held, conducted by a County representative, at which the objects of the Women's Section are clearly explained. A resolution is then passed to form the branch.

This is recorded in triplicate on the appropriate form (one copy for the Branch, one copy for the County and one copy for Head Office).

All eligible members should be enrolled straight away. Nominations for the various offices of the branch can then be proceeded with.
